

2017 Results Statement

Our results for % GCSE 4+ in English and Maths and the Progress 8 measure were in line with national averages when judged against similar pupils and schools nationally. (F.F.T. – 2017 C.V.A.).

A great strength of our school is the number of vocational qualifications on offer to our students. In 2017 we had a 100% pass rate achieving 94 Level 1 qualifications and 18 Level 2 qualifications across 12 subject areas.

The longer a student is with us at New Bridge Academy the more qualifications they achieve and at a higher level of attainment.
